## **WAX CERA**

Everyday cleaning can include using a vacuum cleaner with the head brushes out or sweeping with a brush. Spot clean food spills and dirt with a damp not soaking cloth.

**Wax replenisher:- Element 7 Wax Cera - For regular polishing; biannually, but no more often than quarterly –**

Prior to using Element 7 Cera, vacuum the floor and clean with a solution of Element 7 AE Detergent.

If maintaining a well waxed floor spray Cera directly on the surface without dilution using a mist-spray bottle. Spread this thin layer into the wood and along its grain using a cloth mop. When the floor is dry, polish the surface with floor machine fitted with a white pad.

If maintaining a drier/washed-out floor then pour Cera directly onto the surface and spread a heavier application using a brush. Don't step on the surface as it dries (1 hour). When the floor is dry, polish the surface with floor machine fitted with a white pad to restore the sheen.

The frequency of treatment with Cera depends on the wear the wood surface is subjected to. As a guide: every 3 months for heavy wear, biannually normal wear. Usage: 1 litre per 80m<sup>2</sup> per spray application or 1 litre per 30m<sup>2</sup> when brushed on.
